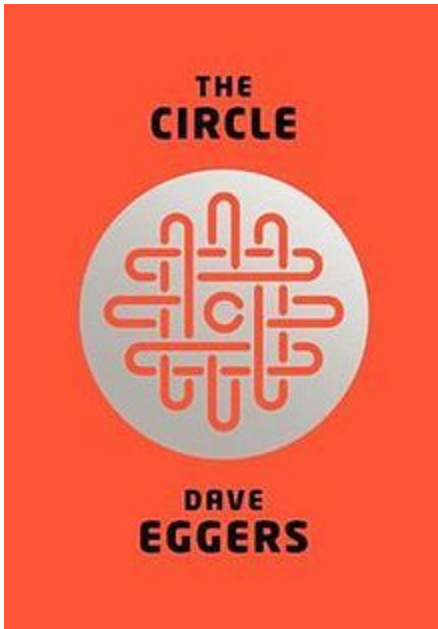


English 2 Enriched Summer Reading
